

#### **Child Health Guidelines**

For the good health of your child and all the children of the Mothers' Center, please do not bring your child to the Mothers' Center if they have:



- Temperature of 99.2 or higher
- Sincere complaints of discomfort
- Swollen glands
- Sore throat
- Excessive discharge from the nose
- Is in the first three days of a cold
- · Persistent cough or sneezing
- · Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Rash or inflammation of the eyelids
- Extreme lethargy
- Chicken pox
- Rash
- · Other contagious disease

Children who have been vomiting and/or had a fever should be kept home for one full day after symptoms have disappeared.
