

Child Health Guidelines

Please do not bring your child to a Mothers' Center activity if he or she has:

- Temperature of 99.2 or more
- Sincere complaints of discomfort
- Swollen glands
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Excessive nasal discharge
- A cold (during first 3 days)
- Persistent cough or sneezing
- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
- Rash or inflammation of the eyelids
- Extreme lethargy
- COVID-19
- Rash
- Other contagious disease
